## Fall Interclub Survey

Some of you are aware that the CCTA Coordinator has been looking at creating a new Fall League that enables us to take advantage of what is typically the best tennis weather of the whole year, the months of October and November. Still in planning, but here's the idea:

Start date will be October 2 or 9 and it will run 9-10 weeks. The play-off dates are still TBD.

CCTA will have a league and Hilton Head will have a league. The winning team of each CCTA flight will have a play-off with the corresponding winners from Hilton Head. (No States).

Entry fees will be \$10 or \$12 per player.

The age groups will be different, giving teams the opportunity to mix it up a bit: 50+, 60+, and if there are enough interested players on both sides of the bridge, 70+. See below for the days of play. You must be a member of USTA and your captain will sign up & form a team # in the same fashion as USTA, but your ratings will NOT be affected by this league.
