THE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



One of the goals of the Women's Tennis Organization of the Sun City Association is to assist high school tennis players in obtaining equipment, training, and tournament experience. The Memorial Scholarship does just that by presenting scholarships to deserving player(s) to further his/her tennis skills for the enjoyment of the game. More than one scholarship may be granted.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Players in grade 7-11.
- Participation on varsity team in current season or season immediately following award at May River HS, Bluffton HS, John Paul II HS, Hilton Head Christian Academy
- Maintain a B average or above upon submission of application.

Players will be selected by their tennis coach/program coordinator to participate in the application process. The Scholarship Committee will determine the final selections for awards. Notification letters will be sent by April 1st.

All funds will be disbursed by the Treasurer of the Sun City Tennis Association to the recipient's coach, parent, or designated adult. Receipts and a brief explanation of all expenses must be sent to the WTO designated person before funds will be distributed.

Acceptable receipts must identify the specific source/affiliation of the product or service purchased. Receipts which do not list a company name and logo will not be accepted. Awards will be rescinded if receipts are not submitted by the deadline. Receipts will not be accepted for a student who did not participate in the varsity season as required. In both of these cases, the student will be ineligible to apply for an award the following year.

THE APPLICANT MUST COMPLETE THE ON-LINE APPLICATION AND SUBMIT IT DIRECTLY TO THE WTO SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS IS MARCH 1ST.

Coaches will be required to also complete an on-line recommendation form for all athletes choosing to complete an application. The Scholarship Committee will send a link to the coach once the student's application is received. Deadline for coaches' recommendation is March 15th.
