If you are new to tennis or want to get back into the game, here are some suggestions.

FOR ALL TENNIS PLAYERS (Residents)

- Any resident of Sun City may use the tennis facility and play on any of the 16 courts.
- Any guest of a resident is welcome to play but is required to pay a guest fee, Call or stop in at the LOGO Building prior to play to arrange payment.
- All clinics and lessons are open to all residents. See the LOGO Building staff or the SCTA website for more information.
- If would like to be rated, you can attend the Rating Clinic held @ 3:00pm on the 1st Saturday of every month. One of our tennis professionals will rate you so that you get a better idea of your level of play. Sign up at the Logo building; there is a \$5 fee. Residents who only want to play socially, do not need a rating.
- The Chelsea Reservation System is used to reserve a court time. Call or stop in at the LOGO Building and the staff will set up your Chelsea account and get you started.
- Join the early risers and play in the Round Robin (Level 2.5 and above) on Mon, Wed and Fri from 7:30am to 9:00am on the south side courts. (Arrive by 7:20am.) Sign up at the LOGO Building.
- To use the Ball Machine on court 4, you will need to attend a Ball Machine Orientation, held
 @ 2:00pm on the 1st Saturday of every month.
